POSITION SUMMARY

Journey of Faith is looking for a passionate and energetic leader to direct the volunteer and guest experiences, setup and teardown teams, and all next step opportunities at the Torrance campus.

This is a full-time position to lead the lead the Setup/Teardown, Guest Services, and Next Step initiatives at the Torrance Campus. This role will work in partnership with the Community Life department of Journey to develop systems and then activate them at the campus level. The person in this position will need to be an energetic team player with the ability to develop volunteers and manage all aspects of the "street to seat" experience during Sunday services.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Ministry

- Oversee guest and volunteer experience at the Torrance campus every Sunday. Lead Hospitality Ministry captains, coaches, and volunteers.
- Care for, develop, empower, and appreciate captains and coaches throughout the week.
- Identify, recruit, and equip volunteers and leaders for guest services, next steps, and setup/teardown.
- Refine the Setup/Teardown process and assess equipment and storage needs.
- Collaborate with the Director of Next Steps at the Manhattan Beach campus and the Community Life department to ensure consistency and excellence between campuses.
- Oversee all aspects of the First Steps and Starting Point at the Torrance campus.
- Occasionally host during Sunday services and run all-volunteer Huddles.
- Partner with Community Life staff for all-church events.
- Integrate and collaborate with the Torrance campus staff team, which includes Campus Pastor,
 Children's Director, Student Ministries Director, Tech Director, and Worship Pastor.

Administrative

- Communicate during the week with coaches and volunteers for scheduling and development.
- Coordinate interest in next steps (baptism, membership, volunteering, etc.).
- Support campus team in planning volunteer and all-campus events.
