Mission and Calling

We believe healthy youth ministry is built on healthy relationships between adult staff and students. Relationships are key to students feeling loved and understanding God's love in practical ways. This is when real spiritual growth takes place in a student's life.

Specific Responsibilities

- Be at a Sunday morning or Tuesday evening meeting where serving
- Be willing to do whatever is needed to help ministry happen that morning or evening (organizing food, setting up for games, asking new students to fill out welcome cards, etc.)
- Be available for large-scale events when necessary
- Be open to any other tasks assigned by the ministry pastor

Spiritual Requirements

- Be a committed Jesus-follower with a lifestyle and reputation of Christian faithfulness.

Ministry Specific Requirements:

- Be a member or be willing to become a member of Journey of Faith.
- Age Requirement: 22+ older
- Must love Teenagers
- Must be honest and vulnerable with their lives and non-judgmental.
- Must be patient and tenacious as working with this demographic is one of the most difficult, yet can be the most rewarding.

Time Commitment:

2-4 hours a week (depending on number of programs participated in)
