Mission and Calling

Our Impact college ministry exists to provide an environment of community, learning, support, and service that complements our weekly worship services and helps 18-22 year olds to grow deeper in their relationship with Jesus Christ and one another. Impact meets on Thursday nights at 7:00pm in the Cove for engaging discussion about the Bible, worship, prayer, and time to connect with friends over pizza.

Specific Responsibilities

As part of a leadership team under the shepherding of the College Ministry pastor, volunteer college ministry leaders will help with:

- Shepherding – creating a safe and exciting environment for people to grow in their faith by encouraging biblical learning, meaningful discussion, prayer, service opportunities, and by modeling a personal life of faith and lifelong followership of Jesus.
- Mentoring – leaders will make time to meet with students on a one-on-one basis outside of the weekly college ministry gathering time for additional support and encouragement as needed.
- Hospitality – set up, clean up, ordering food, and event planning as needed
- Empowering New Leaders – intentional identification and encouragement of potential new student leaders who can help to make an impact in the church and the community.

Spiritual Requirements

- Be a committed Jesus-follower with a lifestyle and reputation of Christian faithfulness.
- Be in agreement with the Mission, Values and Core Beliefs of Journey of Faith.
- Feel a strong calling to Christian discipleship, shepherding, and/or hospitality.
- Feel a strong calling to work with college-age students.
- Has a high level of self-awareness and is committed to continual relational growth.
- Demonstrates Christ-centered living (1 Peter 1:15-16, 1 Timothy 3:1–7; Titus 1:5–9), Honesty, confidence, teachability, and humility (Philippians 2:5-7), and patience and commitment in working with others (James 1:4)

Ministry Specific Requirements:

- Be a member or be willing to become a member of Journey of Faith.
- Willingness to serve for a 1-year commitment to ministry.
- Be available for at least 3 hours of ministry per week at the regular college ministry meeting time and at least 1 additional meeting time with students per month.

Reporting:

Works with and is accountable to the Pastor that oversees college ministry.
